Portfolio managers commentary

The micro-organism Coronavirus has appeared as a spanner in works of planetary human activity. It has highlighted the fragility of some of today's economic value chains, operating just-in-time and stretched across various continents.

The stock markets and the subordinated debt asset class, which had experienced very positive run since the start of 2019, have be severely shaken, having largely ignored this phenomenon one month earlier. This trend reversal has been a clear reminder of past instable times.

Today, with economic activity severely disrupted, a slowing global growth paradigm and turbulent world stock markets, all eyes are focused on central banks and governments to intervene decisively. However, their senior officials are not known to act as quickly as markets participants would wish.

For the USD bond world, we can expect the Federal Reserve to cut interest rates several times, accompanied by an "official" asset purchase program. Likewise, the President of the United States, looking for a second mandate will do everything he can to ensure the economic sustainability of his country.

Until the monetary and political cavalries arrive, markets will remain volatile over the short term. However, once their economic support programs in place, the challenge for international investors will be to find assets with positive returns in a world which is rapidly marching towards zero or negative global interest rates. In a more settled times, the subordinated asset class in USD with its attractive returns will no doubt be at the center of many investors' attention.




